Novice Individual Award Program

Front half of the Fact-pak (available to everyone!)

Any adult that is not a relative to the quizzer may give the test.

This season's program is divided into 12 tests. Certificates will be awarded at each meet.

Meet One: J-1 (ten pointers), B-1 (twenty pointers) and Q-1 (thirty pointers).

Meet Two: J-2 (ten pointers), B-2 (twenty pointers) and Q-2 (thirty pointers).

Meet Three: J-3 (ten pointers), B-3 (twenty pointers) and Q-3 (thirty pointers).

Meet Four: J-4 (ten pointers), B-4 (twenty pointers) and Q-4 (thirty pointers).

- This schedule is designed to follow the question ranges for each meet. However, the certificate awards can be earned any time before the final meet.

If the participant learns only one point value, five awards are still available for him/her to earn over the course of the season. (For example: Joe Cartwright only studies the twenty point questions. Therefore, the awards tests for him would be B-1 (first meet), B-2 (second meet), B-3 (third meet), B-4 (fourth meet). If he passes all four of these tests, he would be presented the **Bible** award at the final meet.

However, if the participant learns all three-point values, 16 awards are available. The **JBQ Medal of Honor** is the top award and requires the participant to pass all the tests for each point value.

The test for each award is verbal and only the answer portion of the question is required. The quizzer's answer is to be judged correct or incorrect according to the National JBQ guidelines. The questions within the question range should be asked in random order, either by generating the questions by computer or by the draw of the fact-pak cards. All the questions within the range of the award must be asked in one setting. A quizzer is allowed to test as many times as necessary to achieve a passing score.

The Junior, Bible, Quizzer, and *JBQ Medal of Honor* awards will be presented at the Final league meet. The requirements for these awards must be met by the end of the third meet so that we can get these special awards ordered for presentation at the Final meet.

Email J'Nell the award recipient's name, the score(s), and the award(s) earned by 10 p.m. on the Wednesday prior to the meet. Certificates will be printed and presented at the awards ceremony after each meet.
