

(16-5-10s) Moses – Commandments

GO-WORD is **God**

God met Moses at the burning bush in the desert near Mount Sinai and made a promise to rescue the Israelites out of Egypt where they were currently slaves. Moses with the help of his brother Aaron went back to Egypt and demanded the Pharaoh King of Egypt let the Israelites go. It took 10 plagues sent upon the land of Egypt to persuade the Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. **God** sent a river of blood, frogs, lice, flies, sickness, boils or blisters, fire hail, locust or grasshoppers, darkness and then **God** sent the worst one. **On the last plague on Egypt God sent the death of the firstborn.** During the last plague **God** spared the Israelites if they covered their door threshold with the blood of a lamb for protection. Ever since that time **God** established a feast to remember the Israelites deliverance from Egypt and called it **Passover**, because the angel of death passed over the Israelites home which was protected by the blood of the lamb.

After the tenth plague of the death of the firstborn Pharaoh let the people go and Moses took all the people and his family out of Egypt, including Miriam who was Moses' sister. They got to the Red Sea and Pharaoh changed his mind. **They had nowhere to go, it was either be killed by Pharaoh or drown in the Red Sea and God provided a miracle by parting the Red Sea.** The Israelites crossed on dry land and when Egyptians tried to follow the parted sea closed and they were all drowned.

God kept the Israelites from thirst and starvation. At a place called Marah there was water but it was bitter. The people needed water and **God** had Moses throw a piece of wood into the bitter water and make it fresh again. When the people were hungry **God** sent mana from heaven, a bread like substance which appeared in the morning on the ground. At Rephidim there was no water at all, so **God** gave them water and it came from rock after Moses struck it with his staff

They were attacked by people in the wilderness called the Amalekites and during the battle Moses watched from a hilltop and **God** told him to hold up his hands and they would win. Moses held his hands up and they were winning but when he dropped his hands they began to lose. **Aaron and Hur stood by Moses side and kept his hands up till they won the battle over the Amalekites.**

Moses spent a lot of time talking to **God** and on Mount Sinai **God** gave Moses the ten commandments. This week we focus on the first four which deal with our relationship to **God**.

#1 - Exodus 20:3 "You must not have any other **God** but me."

#2 - Exodus 20:4 "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind."

#3 - Exodus 20:7 "You must not misuse the name of the Lord your **God**."

#4 - Exodus 20:8 "Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy."

In the New Testament, Jesus gave us only two commands, the first was Love the Lord your **God** with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. These first four Old Testament commandments are all defined in Jesus' first commandment which basically say put **God** first. The second commandment of Jesus was Love your neighbor as yourself which make up the remaining commandments which we do next week. **The fifth commandment Paul tells us has a promise. Honor your father and mother**, that your days may be long upon the earth.

(16-5-20s) Resurrection and Sin

GO-WORD is Jesus, God

After Jesus' resurrection he walked and talked with His apostles for forty days. Jesus was seen alive after his resurrection by more than five hundred people. The resurrection of Jesus proved exactly who he claimed to be, the Son of God, our Savior, and Lord. If Jesus had not been raised from the dead the teachings of the Bible or doctrine of our Christian faith become useless. The sinless sacrifice Jesus made was for our sins and if he had not sinned it would not have had the power to pay or atone for our sins.

After the forty days he ascended into heaven and Jesus is in heaven now sitting at the right hand of God the Father pleading or interceding for us who are believers. He is our mediator just like the Old Testament priest duties were to intercede with God for the people and offer sacrifices to atone or pay for their sins. Jesus gave his life for our sins and because he is God the Son, he conquered death and is alive today. Jesus will always be there, in Revelation we find Jesus great I am saying: *Revelation 22:13 "I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End."* This verse in Revelations tells us Jesus will always be there for us.

Ever since Adam and Eve we have had sin in the world. Adam was created from the dust of the ground and God breathed the breath of life into him. God created Eve from one of Adam's ribs to be his companion. People were created in the image of God with a spiritual nature which permits them to reason, make choices, and to know and love God. The first sin is referred to as the original sin and was committed by Adam and Eve when they chose sin by disobeying God. Because Adam and Eve are the parents of everyone we are born in sin and have the tendency to sin, we inherit the original sin.

When Adam and Eve sinned God provided them clothing from the skins of animals which was the first blood sacrifice made for sin, but it was only temporary. The priests of the Old Testament their duties were to make blood sacrifices for sins of people, and they did until Jesus gave his life for our sins.
