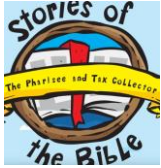

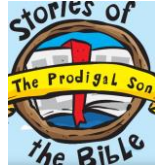

361 = **In Jesus'** story of the Pharisee and tax collector, what was the tax collector's prayer?

"O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner."

362 = **What did the** Prodigal Son say to his father when he came back home?

Father, I have sinned against both heaven [God] and you, and I am no longer worthy of being called your son.'

363 = **How important is the blood** of Jesus to our salvation?

Without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness of sin.

364 = **What is meant by the** vicarious atonement?

Jesus [Christ] took the punishment for our sins when He died on Calvary, and if we accept Him as Savior we will not have to be punished by God.

Romans 1:16 For I am not ashamed of this Good News about Christ. It is the power of God at work, saving everyone who believes.

Ephesians 2:8 God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God.

Because we are saved, we do good things to show our love for God.

1 Corinthians 13:13 Three things will last forever— faith, hope, and love—and the greatest of these is love.

370 = **According to Hebrews** 11:6, those who come to God must believe what?

They must believe that God exists and that He rewards those who sincerely seek Him.

371 = **QUOTATION QUESTION. What did Jesus say was the first** and most important commandment?

Mark 12:30 "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength."

372 = **QUOTATION QUESTION. What did Jesus say was the second-most** important commandment?

Mark 12:31 "Love your neighbor as yourself."
