Jesus taught and preached about three and a half years before His crucifixion. Jesus was about 30 years old when he began His public ministry. It all started with His baptism by John the Baptist in the Jordan River. When He came to John to be baptized John recognized who he was and introduced Jesus with these words quoting John 1:29" "Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! John the Baptist baptized with just water symbolizing a rebirth in a new way of life. After Jesus was raised from the water at His baptism God showed his approval of Jesus and the Holy Spirit descended on Him and the Father said "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Then John the Baptist told everyone Jesus would baptize with the Holy Spirit and

Jesus went from his baptism to pray and fast and was tempted by Satan. During Jesus' temptation he went without eating for forty days and nights.

After defeating Satan's temptations with the word of God Jesus began selecting his disciples. Andrew was first and when he went to tell his brother Simon Peter he announced, "We have found the Messiah". Andrew and Peter were fishermen and they had two friends who were fishermen which Jesus called as well. These first four apostles were Peter, Andrew, James, and John. Another disciple was a tax collector name Matthew who wrote a gospel. Nicodemus was a ruler of the Jesus that came to Jesus by night seeking the way to eternal life. He is important not as an apostle but played part in Jesus' burial and resurrection.

Jesus had many people who wanted to follow him. There is a story of a rich young leader who asked to follow Jesus but failed. When Jesus asked him to sell all he had first and give to the poor he could not. Because he loved the things he owned more than Jesus he failed to follow Jesus. Jesus prophesied the Temple would be destroyed and that not one stone would be left on another.

Jesus' first miracle was turning water into wine at a wedding in Cana. Jesus did many miracles and even showed His power for nature by calming a storm on the Sea of Galilee. His most famous sermon is called the Sermon on the Mount where he described people beginning with the words "God Blesses" they were later called the Beatitudes because in the original language they all began with the same letters "beati"

About this time John the Baptist was thrown in prison by King Herod. His stepdaughter persuaded King Herod to kill John the Baptist by beheading him.

Jesus proved over and over he was the Son of God. Once he took Peter, James, and John to a high mountain. While up

there Jesus' appearance was transformed, and he talked with Moses and Elijah. Proving again he was the Son of God.

After Jesus' ascension into heaven the disciples went to Jerusalem to wait for the Holy Spirit. It was on the day of Pentecost they were in an upper room everyone was praying

Pentecost they were in an upper room everyone was praying and Acts 2:4 says: And everyone present was filled with the Holy Spirit and began speaking in other languages, as the Holy Spirit gave them this ability. There were 120 people total praying that received the baptism in the Holy Spirit. This did not go unnoticed, and Peter began to preach to people in the streets around them with a call to salvation in Acts 2:38 it says: "Each of you must repent of your sins and turn to God and be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. Then you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day – about 3000 in all.

Because of this event we know the initial physical evidence of being filled with the Holy Spirit is speaking in other languages or tongues as the Holy Spirit enables. This happened more than once where people were saved and then filled with the Holy Spirit by speaking with other tongues as the initial physical evidence of the baptism in the Holy Spirit became the pattern of the New Testament Church.

GO-WORD is Holy Spirit (9)

What may you ask is the purpose of the Holy Spirit? It is threefold:

- To help us know Jesus better
- To assist us in understanding God's Word
- To give us power to witness

Church is defined in the Bible as consisting of born-again people who have been called out from the world; who have faith in and give allegiance to the Lord Jesus Christ. The first church was formed in Jerusalem on the day of Pentecost and Jesus [Christ] is not just the foundation but the head of the church.

Paul who wrote more books of the Bible than any other person became a part of the church a few years later. Paul went on several missionary journeys leading people to salvation and being filled with the Holy Spirit. We learn through Paul that salvation and the baptism in the Holy Spirit are not the same. While at Ephesus Paul asked the Christian if they had received the Holy Spirit since they believed.

Paul in Romans 14:17 we learn that in God's kingdom the Holy Spirit is one of three things which make it up and they are:

- Righteousness
- Peace
- Joy in the Holy Spirit

One last point Jeremiah 1:5 tells us God knows us before we are born. I knew you before I formed you in your mother's womb. Before you were born, I set you apart. By this we know life begins before we take our first breath and God has a plan for our lives.
