Jesus taught his disciples many things, there was once while teaching his disciples he asked them who they thought he was. Peter replied in Matthew 16:16 saying "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." The three disciples Peter, James, and John were Jesus' closest friends, and this is best shown in that they were the three chosen to go up on the high mountain where he was transformed and spoke to Moses and Elijah.

A disciple is a learner of Jesus. Jesus taught with parables telling familiar stories and later explaining to his disciples the spiritual truths. There is the parable of the wise and foolish man who built a house. The foolish man built on sand which was an example of those who hear His teachings but do not obey them. The wise man built on the rock which showed those who hear His teachings and follow them. Jesus also told the parable of the Good Samaritan who helped the man who was beaten and robbed and then explaining to his disciples this is the example we should follow. Another parable is The Sower who planted seeds and depending on where the seed fell determines how the plant grows. The seed Jesus later explained was the Word of God. Then there is the rich man who had more than he needed and when he died, he could not take it with him. The point being, don't be greedy your life is not measured by how much you own. The parable of the Prodigal Son, prodigal means wasteful. The son left his father taking his inheritance and spending it all to the point he could not take care of himself, the son repented, and the father took him back in with forgiveness. Jesus was telling us in the Prodigal Son story, God is willing to forgive and restore the sinner who repents. Jesus was asked should we pay taxes, and his answer was "Give Caesar what belongs to Caesar and give God what belongs to God."

Jesus not only taught but did many miracles. There was the man born blind and Jesus put mud on his eyes and told him to go and wash it off and the man could see. Jesus was teaching to a group of five thousand men, plus women and children. Jesus took a boy's lunch of five loaves and two fishes and fed everyone. Zacchaeus was a tax collector and became so curious to see Jesus he climbed a tree to see him. The miracle is that Zacchaeus repented and became an honest tax collector, returning to the people he had cheated four times over and he gave half of everything he had to the poor because of Jesus.

In Jesus last days before his crucifixion, he came into Jerusalem riding on the colt of a donkey in a Triumphal Entry fulfilling an Old Testament prophecy. He had a last supper with his disciples and humbly washed each of the disciple's feet. This was the night before his crucifixion and Jesus went to the garden of Gethsemane to pray. After he prayed, Roman guards came to arrest him. Judas Iscariot one of his apostles betrayed him with a kiss and showing the guards which man was Jesus. Jesus was taken before several rulers before they finally sentenced him to death on the cross. Peter followed as close as he could because he was anxious about the outcome. Three times he was confronted about being one of Jesus' disciples and three times he denied it. On the last denial a rooster crowed. Peter ran away because he remembered Jesus had prophesied that Peter would deny knowing Jesus three times.

Paul describes the church in his writing with three figures of speech a body, a building, and a bride. The church is like a body in that it has different parts which work together, just as each of us brings our talents and abilities to the church. We all work together with our differences to make the church effective. The church is like a bride such that we are one with Christ who loves and takes care of us. The church is like a building such as a house with its foundation built on Jesus Christ. Jesus also describe himself as the one who builds the church, when Jesus changed Simon's name to Peter (which means rock), he told Peter he would build his church upon the rock. The mission of the church is stated at the end of the Gospels, in Mark 16:15 it says, "Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone.".

When Jesus was throwing the money changers out of the church, Jesus said that the church was a house of prayer. Prayer is talking to God and the church building is a place where we meet God together in prayer. Prayer is most powerful when we come to God united in seeking Him. The Bible says Matthew 18:19 "If two of you agree here on earth concerning anything you ask, my Father in heaven will do it for you.".

GO-WORD is church (12)

We are all called to use our talents an ability for God. There are also evangelists, pastors, and teachers which we say have a "calling to the ministry". A Calling to the Ministry is when a person has a special impression of the Spirit to serve the Lord through a particular area of ministry. God also gives us ministers or pastors to help Christians grow so they can help others.

The church is supported by the tithe and offerings for those whom it ministers. Tithe is one tenth of one's income, which belongs to God and should be given to the church to support its ministries. The reason we give a tenth was because Abraham was the first to pay a tithe of one tenth to Melchizedek and that set the standard. Offerings are not tithe but are something given in worship to God in addition to the tithe. All we have, was given to us by God and he allows us to manage it for him. We are a part of his church, and we help support it through what we give in money, time, and talents.

In the beginning God took six days to create the world and rested on the seventh. The day of rest in the Old Testament is the Sabbath and it was set aside to worship God. There was a change after Jesus' resurrection, because Jesus was resurrected on a Sunday the first day of the week the first Christians began to make Sunday a day of worship and meeting together in the church, and we continue to do it today. Because Jesus fulfilled the Sabbath, we worship and rest on the day of His resurrection.
