When Jesus was brought before Pilate, Pilate could not find any fault with Jesus. In the hopes of saving Jesus, he offered the people a choice between releasing Barabbas a convicted thief and robber and Jesus. The people chose to ask Pilate to release Barabbas instead of Jesus.

Jesus was sentence to death by being crucified and nailed to a cross on a hill called "Golgotha" which means The Place of the Skull. Pilate had a marker placed on Jesus' cross which read "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews". As Jesus hung on the cross the sun became dark for three hours and there was an earthquake. The Bible tells us the Roman officer who oversaw Jesus' execution said, "This man truly was the Son of God!" and then Jesus died.

After Jesus had died, Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus wrapped his body and buried him in a tomb. There were people who worried Jesus body would be stolen and had Pilate put guards outside his tomb. On the third day angels came and rolled away the stone in front of Jesus' tomb and the guards ran away afraid. Mary Magdalene and a friend came that morning and Mary Magdalene was the first person to see Jesus after He was resurrected. She ran quickly back to town to tell the other disciples. All but Thomas saw Jesus shortly after in a closed room and when the others told Thomas he at first doubted Jesus' was resurrected. Thomas believed when he saw him. More than 500 people saw Jesus after he was raised from the dead. Jesus' Apostles walked and talked with him for about 40 days after his resurrection and then he was taken up into a cloud until they could no longer see him.

Jesus Apostles then went to Jerusalem to pray and wait for the Holy Spirit. While waiting they chose to replace Judas as an Apostle and chose Matthias a man who had traveled with them since Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist.

On the day of Pentecost there were 120 people waiting together in an upstairs room for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Old Testament prophet Joel had foretold the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and it was on the day of Pentecost the gift of God was given to the Church, the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

Peter began to preach a sermon afterward to the people near the building. There were about 3000 people saved because of Peter's sermon on the Day of Pentecost.

One day Peter and a friend were going to church and there was a lame man at the temple gate and God healed him after Peter said to him: Acts 3:6 "I don't have any silver or gold for you. But I'll give you what I have. In the name of Jesus Christ, the Nazarene, get up and walk!"

The church grew and with honesty and love the people gave and shared everything with one another. A husband-and-wife Ananias and Saphira joined the church and lied to the Holy Spirit about what they had to share and were punished for their sin.

The two ordinances of the Church are Water Baptism and Communion. An ordinance is a custom or practice and both ordinances were established by Jesus.

Jesus told his disciples just before his ascension into heaven "go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." Which tells us everyone who believes in Jesus as Savior should be baptized. The proper method of baptism is immersion (full body underwater), which symbolizes the death of the old sinful nature and a new life in Christ. All people who are baptized should be done in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Paul explains the purpose of communion or the Lord's Supper in 1Corinthians 11:26 "For every time you eat this bread and drink this cup, you are announcing the Lord's death until he comes again." In Communion, the bread represents the body of Jesus, and the cup represents His blood which He shed for our sins. Anyone can partake at the Communion service, the judge of who is worthy to partake is left to each person to examine themselves.

Death came into the world as result of willful sin when Adam and Eve disobeyed God. God sent his Son to suffer and die for our sins. Matthew 8:17 "This fulfilled the word of the Lord through the prophet Isaiah, who said, 'He took our sicknesses and removed our diseases." Shows that Jesus also fulfilled Isaiah's prophecy of Jesus's power to heal. Jesus took our sickness and removed our diseases. Jesus' healings were miracles and in Peter's sermon on Pentecost he stated these miracles, wonders, and signs were God's endorsement or approval of Jesus his Son.

When we sin, it will bring misfortune and should be avoided but we learn a great lesson from the book of Job. Not all misfortune which comes to a believer is punishment for sin.
