Matthew 24:35 "Heaven and earth will disappear, but my words will never disappear." (NLT)

King James Version:

Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass away.

New International Version:

Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.

The Message:

This age continues until all these things take place. Sky and earth will wear out; my words won't wear out.

The Voice:

My words are always true and always here with you.
Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will never pass away.

Definitions & Synonyms

Disappear: cease to exist; vanish from sight

My Words: the Bible

Heaven: the sky; God's home

Earth: land, our planet; our home

Last: final appearance or mention, time length

Story (Matthew 24:3-35)

³ Later, Jesus sat on the Mount of Olives. His disciples came to him privately and said, "Tell us, when will all this happen? What sign will signal your return and the end of the world?"^[a]


...

³⁰ And then at last, the sign that the Son of Man is coming will appear in the heavens, and there will be deep mourning among all the peoples of the earth. And they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.^[h] ³¹ And he will send out his angels with the mighty blast of a trumpet, and they will gather his chosen ones from all over the world^[i]—from the farthest ends of the earth and heaven.

³² "Now learn a lesson from the fig tree. When its branches bud and its leaves begin to sprout, you know that summer is near. ³³ In the same way, when you see all these things, you can know his return is very near, right at the door. ³⁴ I tell you the truth, this generation^[j] will not pass from the scene until all these things take place. ³⁵ Heaven and earth will disappear, but my words will never disappear.

³⁶ "However, no one knows the day or hour when these things will happen, not even the angels in heaven or the Son himself.^[k] Only the Father knows.

On the Mount of Olives Jesus taught his disciples privately. Matthew chapter 24 tells the story of the teachings. In the teachings Jesus tells his disciples and us that the Word of God will last beyond anything we can see and touch. God's word will be with us yesterday, today and forever. We can rely on God.
