Goals

Start JBQ in your church stand alone. The Bible Fact-Pak 10-point questions cover all the major stories in the Bible and is the good general information for understanding why the Bible is important to our lives and future. Because everything is internal to your church you have complete control over how the competition runs. Competition through games has proven itself to be successful in teaching and understanding. If you wish to go further there are 20-point and 30-point questions as well as district events using all the questions.

Weekly Practice

(10-15 minutes)

Word Stories giving prizes or treats for successfully counting word occurrences. This can be played with kids who show up on time and is flexible enough to allow late kids to join in as they arrive.

(10-15 minutes)

Focus Verse each week have a Quotation Question Focus Verse (Memory Verse) work with the kids to memorize it during practice using song and explaining the meaning of words and why the verse is important. Challenge them to come back next practice with it memorized and encourage them with a prize/treat.

(15-20 minutes)

Practice Rounds using sets of 18 ten-point questions as generated from https://biblefactpak.com/.

Note: Create sets using custom option using 18 tens and 2 twenties, make all the substitute and overtime twenties and it will generate a perfect set of 18 questions with duplicates. When reading just ignore twenty-point questions.

Home Study

Study Guides can be sent home each week for the next practice. Have each family purchase a <u>Bible Fact-Pak</u> Questions Book or <u>Bible Fact-Pak</u> Question Cards from https://myhealthychurch.com search JBQ.

Self-Study Videos are on https://www.jbq.org/self-study-videos/. These videos can be copied onto a flash drive and plugged into USB port of most TV and viewed by students for self-study without fear of them exploring the internet.

The Bible Facts

The Bible's definition can be defined in three ways:

- 1> The Bible is the God's inspired Word.
- 2> The Bible is the God's revelation to all people of himself.
- 3> The Bible is the God's plan of salvation for all people.

By inspired Word we mean God gave the writers each Word of the Bible, not just the thoughts and ideas. God's revelation means God shows us who he is. In the Old Testament God's plan of salvation was to give an animal blood sacrifice for our sins. In the New Testament God's plan of salvation was to give his son Jesus as blood sacrifice for our sin.

The Bible is not just one book but is composed of sixty-six books and the Bible is divided into two divisions the Old and New Testament; testament means covenant, contract, or agreement. The Old Testament contains 39 books. The New Testament contains 27 books. The Bible was written by about forty different people over a period of 1600 years.

Bible (8)

The Bible was not written in English the language we speak today. The Old Testament was written in Hebrew and the New Testament was written in Greek; both were translated to English later. Therefore, we have many different versions of the Bible in English. They all are the true Word of God just translated differently to help people to understand the meaning of the original text.

The first book of the Bible which tells us about the beginning of the world, is Genesis. Genesis is part of the Pentateuch which is another name for the first five books of the Bible written by Moses. The Old Testament of thirty-nine books are divided into four sections, Law (5 books), History (12 books), Poetry (5 books), and Prophets (17 books). In the five books of Poetry is the book of Psalms which is the longest book in the Bible with 150 chapters and is a collection of hymns and songs.

The New Testament begins with the four gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John. Gospel means "Good News" and the theme of the four gospels is the life and teachings of Jesus. After the four gospels we have the book of Acts which tells us about the beginnings of the Early Church. After Acts we come to the thirteen books written by Paul who wrote more books in the Bible than any other person. The last book of the Bible is Revelation, and it is composed almost entirely of prophecies of the future.

Psalms is the longest book in the Bible with 150 chapters. King David wrote many of the Psalms, and they are a great source for encouragement from God. Psalm 117 is the shortest chapter with 2 verses, and both give praise to God. Psalm 119 just two chapters away is the longest chapter with 176 verses and is about the Word of God and its great value. King David wrote most of the longest book, but Paul the apostle wrote more books than any other person. Those books are called epistles because they were letters sent by an apostle. The epistles of Paul were shared by the early church believers.

Genesis the first book in the Bible tells us about the beginnings of the world. It tells us where the universe came from: Genesis 1:1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Adam and Eve were the first man and woman. God created them in his own image, and we are different than animals. God created us in his image both inside and out. We have a spiritual nature which permits us to reason, make choices and to know and love God. Adam and Eve were created in a sinless world but because they were created like God, they had a choice of what they could do. God gave them a garden, in which there were two trees God said not to eat from: the tree of the knowledge of good and evil and the tree of life. They disobeyed God by eating from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. They were sent out of the garden and sin entered the world through their disobedience.

Adam and Eve later had two sons named Cain and Abel, the first two brothers. When they were grown Cain became jealous of Abel and in jealousy murdered him. Cain was the first murderer.

The people continued to have sons and daughters and Genesis records many of the fathers and sons and how long they lived. A man called Enoch it was recorded that God took him to heaven when he was 365 without dying because he walked faithfully with God. His son Methuselah lived longer than any other person to an age of 969 years.

After many generations many of the people had become wicked and thought about evil all the time. Methuselah's grandson Noah was a righteous man and faithful to God. Noah had three sons, Shem, Ham, and Japheth. God was going to destroy the world with a flood for their great wickedness, but God was going to spare Noah and his family from the Great Flood. After Jacob stole the birthright from his twin brother Esau, Jacob ran away. While running away, Jacob camped one night and as he slept, he had a dream of a stairway reaching to heaven. In the dream God made the same promise to him as he did Abraham, "that his descendants will be as numerous as the dust of the earth!" When Jacob awoke, he named that place Bethel (which means "house of God").

Jacob continued to Haran where his uncle Laban lived. While in Haran he married Leah and Rachel. Jacob worked many years for Laban and then decided to go home and make peace with his brother. While camping along the way Jacob wrestled with an angel of God and would not let go without a blessing, so the angel blessed Jacob and gave him the new name of Israel.

Jacob's wife Rachel was the mother of Joseph and Benjamin. Joseph shared a dream that made all his brother jealous, the dream was he would be a great ruler someday, and his family would bow down to him. Jacob had a special love for Joseph more than the others and gave Joseph a coat of many colors.

Joseph's brothers in jealousy sold him off to Egypt as a slave and told his father a wild animal had killed Joseph. In Egypt Joseph's first master was Potiphar. Potiphar put Joseph in charge to run his house. While running Potiphar's house his wife asked Joseph to do something that was a sin. When Joseph refused to commit the sin, he was put into prison.

Joseph was in prison and shortly after Pharaoh's baker and cupbearer were thrown in prison, each had a dream and asked Joseph to interpret the dreams. Joseph asked the cupbearer to remember him.

Two years later the Pharaoh had a dream and the cupbearer remembered Joseph and Pharaoh called for him to come and interpret his dream. Joseph through God gave the meaning of Pharaoh's dream, that seven good years would be followed by seven years of famine. Pharaoh appointed Joseph to prepare for the famine. Joseph was given a wife and had two sons, Ephraim, and Manasseh.

Seven years later, Joseph's brothers came to Egypt because of famine to buy food. Joseph told his brothers who he was and invited them to come to Egypt. Jacob and his family settled in Egypt in the land of Goshen.

Word Story – 16-5 (073-090) Moses Out of Egypt

God met Moses at the burning bush in the desert near Mount Sinai and made a promise to rescue the Israelites out of Egypt where they were currently slaves. Moses with the help of his brother Aaron went back to Egypt and demanded the Pharoah King of Egypt let the Israelites go. It took 10 plagues sent upon the land of Egypt to persuade the Pharaoh to let the Israelites go. God sent a river of blood, frogs, lice, flies, sickness, boils or blisters, fire hail, locust or grasshoppers, darkness and then God sent the worst one. On the last plague on Egypt God sent the death of the firstborn. During the last plague God spared the Israelites if they covered their door threshold with the blood of a lamb for protection. Ever since that time God established a feast to remember the Israelites deliverance from Egypt and called it Passover, because the angel of death passed over the Israelites home which was protected by the blood of the lamb.

After the tenth plague of the death of the firstborn Pharoah let the people go and Moses took all the people and his family out of Egypt, including Miriam who was Moses' sister. They got to the Red Sea and Pharoah changed his mind. They had nowhere to go, it was either be killed by Pharoah or drown in the Red Sea and God provided a miracle by parting the Red Sea. The Israelites crossed on dry land and when Egyptians tried to follow the parted sea closed and they were all drowned.

God kept the Israelites from thirst and starvation. At a place called Marah there was water but it was bitter. The people needed water and God had Moses throw a piece of wood into the bitter water and make it fresh again. When the people were hungry God sent mana from heaven, a bread like substance which appeared in the morning on the ground. At Rephidim there was no water at all, so God gave them water and it came from rock after Moses struck it with his staff

They were attacked by people in the wilderness called the Amalekites and during the battle Moses watched from a hilltop and God told him to hold up his hands and they would win. Moses held his hands up and they were winning but when he dropped his hands they began to lose. Aaron and Hur stood by Moses side and kept his hands up till they won the battle over the Amalekites.

Moses spent a lot of time talking to God and on Mount Sinai God gave Moses the ten commandments. This week we focus on the first four which deal with our relationship to God.

#1 - Exodus 20:3 "You must not have any other God but me."

#2 - Exodus 20:4 "You must not make for yourself an idol of any kind."

#3 - Exodus 20:7 "You must not misuse the name of the Lord your God."

#4 - Exodus 20:8 "Remember to observe the Sabbath day by keeping it holy."

In the New Testament, Jesus gave us only two commands, the first was Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength. These first four Old Testament commandments are all defined in Jesus' first commandment which basically say put God first. The second commandment of Jesus was Love your neighbor as yourself which make up the remaining commandments which we do next week. The fifth commandment Paul tells us has a promise. Honor your father and mother, that your days may be long upon the earth.

Word Story – 16-6 (091-108) Wandering in the Wilderness

God gave the Israelites 10 commandments to live by and they are first recorded in Exodus chapter 20. The first four were how to serve God by making him number one in your life. The remaining 6 commandments were how to respect other people. Jesus gave us two commandments to live by, the first to put God first and love him with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind and all your strength. The second command was to love your neighbor as yourself.

Commandment five is honor your father and mother. Commandment six is "You must not murder" which defines the sacredness of human life. Commandment seven is "You must not commit adultery" which protects the sacredness of marriage. Commandment eight is "You must not steal" which protects our right to own possessions. Commandment nine is "You must not testify falsely against your neighbor" which prohibits lying by always telling the truth. Commandment ten is "You must not covet anything that belongs to your neighbor" which forbids wrong desires and jealousy.

When God gave Moses the ten commandments, he was up on Mount Sinai for a long time. So long that the people thought Moses had died and they had Aaron make an idol of a golden calf that they could worship as God. The sin of making and worshipping the idol of the golden calf caused God to punish many of them.

God (6)

God then called Moses to build the Tabernacle in which the people could worship God. From the tribe of Levi God chose the priests to offer sacrifices to God for the people. The main purpose of the sacrifices and offerings was to purify the Israelites of their sins.

God led the people through the wilderness to Canaan with a cloud by day and a pillar of fire by night. When they arrived at the border, they sent 12 spies to see what kind of land it was and what kind of people lived there. Those twelve went to investigate and brought back evidence and information which would show what kind of land it was. Along with information about the land they brought back fruit from the land. Only two of the spies Joshua and Caleb, believed God would give them the land. The other ten said the people were too big and did not believe God could help them take the land. Well, the people did not go into Canaan but spent 40 years wandering in the wilderness.

They suffered many hardships and even doubted Moses and Aaron were God's chosen leaders. God caused Aaron's staff to sprout leaves and bud as proof that Moses and Aaron were God's chosen leaders. Once they camped in a place where there were many poisonous snakes, and the

people were dying from the snake bites. God told Moses to make a bronze snake and lift it up high so the people could look upon it and if they did God healed them. Another time they camped in a place called Meribah with no water, but this time God told Moses to speak to the rocks and the people would have water. Moses went to the rocks but got so angry with the people instead of speaking to the rock he struck it with his staff. Water came from the rock because of God but God punished Moses for disobeying Him.

Word Story – 16-7 (109-126) Joshua, Samson, Ruth, Samuel

Moses was not allowed to go into the land of Canaan because he failed to trust God and demonstrate holiness to the Israelites at Meribah. God took Moses up to a high mountain called Nebo to see the promise land and then the Bible says God buried Moses. Moses lived 120 years before he died.

God appointed Joshua to lead the Israelites after Moses. Joshua and Caleb were the only two men who left Egypt and entered Canaan. Under Joshua's leadership spies were again sent into Canaan and they went to Jericho. They were almost discovered but Rahab a woman who lived in Jericho protected them. She helped them escape from Jericho and in return the spies told her to hang a scarlet rope in the window of her house as a marker to protect her when Jericho was captured.

The spies returned to Joshua, and they set off for Jericho in Canaan. They first had to cross the Jordan river which was very deep for the time of year it was. God performed a miracle there by stopping the flow of the Jordan river during its flood stage and the people were able to cross over into the Promised land on dry ground. They came to the walls of Jericho and marched around the walls thirteen times once each day for six days and seven times on the seventh day. After they marched at Joshua's command, they all shouted together, and the walls of Jericho collapsed.

Jericho was the first victory and the next placed attacked was a small city called Ai. At this battle they were defeated, and Joshua asked God why. God told him it was because of a sin committed by Achan that they were defeated at Ai. Achan repented and was punished and then they were able to defeat Ai. At Gibeon, Joshua and the people were winning but they were running out of daylight. Joshua prayed and a miracle occurred, the sun and the moon stood still, and they won the battle. Joshua continued to lead the people and took back the land of Canaan the land God promised to Israel.

After Joshua's death there arose judges in the land to lead the people in times of war. Gideon was a judge whom God called when the Midianites attacked. With only three hundred men God helped Gideon defeat the Midianites.

One of the last judges and a priest was Samuel. At an early age God called Samuel and one of the first judgements he made was against another priest named Eli.

The people still worshiped God in a tabernacle which could easily be moved. The tabernacle was where they kept the ark of the covenant. According to the book of Hebrews the ark of the covenant was a sacred box which contained the stone tablets of the Ten Commandments, the gold jar of mana, and Aaron's staff that had sprouted leaves.

After many years of judges, the Israelites wanted a king instead of a judge, because they wanted to be like other nations. Samuel anointed the first king of Israel, and his name was Saul. Saul started out well as King, but pride got in his way and Saul rejected God's command and did things his way and God rejected Saul.

Samuel (3)

As a young boy God chose David to be the next king of Israel and Samuel anointed him as well. David did not become king right away but grew up doing many great things. David killed a bear and a lion with a sling as a boy and that alone sounds great but later David took the sling and killed the giant called Goliath. He grew up serving God in the army of Saul and David was best friends with Saul's son Jonathon. David was put in charge of his army and his commander was Joab. Together with Joab they won many battles, so many that Saul became jealous and wanted to kill David. There was a time Saul was chasing David and David had an opportunity to kill Saul but refused because God had chosen Saul to be king.

After Saul died God chose David to become king. David ruled as king for forty years. He was a warrior king and spent much of the time at war defending his throne even from David's own son Absalom who tried to take the kingdom from him. David was a good king and when it was discovered that Jonathan had a son, he showed Mephibosheth kindness by taking care of him. David is credited for writing much of the book of Psalms, David wrote Psalm 139, and it tells us life begins before birth in the mother's womb. David sought God in everything he did, and God told David to choose Solomon David's son to be king after his death.

Solomon began his reign as king seeking God and God gifted Solomon with wisdom when he became king. God

blessed Solomon with many things, Solomon took the tabernacle tent and built a permanent building and called it The Temple of the Lord. Solomon became rich and famous so much so that the queen of Sheba came to visit him.

Rehoboam the son of Solomon became king after Solomon, but Rehoboam did not treat the people well and ten of the twelve tribes of Israel rebelled and formed their own kingdom. After Solomon's death the Israelites divided into the Kingdoms of Israel and Judah. The southern kingdom of Judah was ruled by Rehoboam and in the northern kingdom of Israel the people chose Jeroboam to be their king. Jeroboam established idol worship in the northern kingdom of Israel so the people wouldn't go to Jerusalem to offer sacrifices. He feared that if the people went to Jerusalem, they might follow Rehoboam because Jerusalem was in his kingdom of Judah.

A few kings later there arose a prophet of God named Elijah when the evil king and queen of Israel were Ahab and Jezebel. King Ahab worshiped the false god of Baal, and he made a challenge to Elijah to see which god was greater the God of Israel or Baal. They built an altar with a sacrifice on it and took turns praying to their god to consume the sacrifice. The Baal prophets went first and prayed all day long and nothing happened. Then Elijah prayed and God came down an consumed the sacrifice and the rock altar with fire, God did this so that all of Israel would know hat God was really God.

Well Elijah was prophet for many years and through God did many amazing things. When it came time for him to step down, God came and took Elijah directly to heaven in a whirlwind, his successor was Elisha which witness God taking Elijah. Elisha and Elijah have similar names the difference is a j and sh, j comes before s just as Elijah comes before Elisha.

Elisha through God performed many great miracles as well and became famous. A Syrian officer name Naaman came to him for healing of a bad skin disease called leprosy and Elisha told him from behind his house door to wash in the muddy Jordan River and he would be healed. Reluctantly he did it and God healed him. Another famous miracle during this time was for king Hezekiah where God caused the sun to move backwards to show that God had healed him

After a long time of kings who did not serve God, God allowed Judah to be taken captive by the city of Babylon. Jeremiah was a prophet when they were conquered and wrote many sad things about this bad experience and because of this he is known as the weeping prophet. King Nebuchadnezzar ruled Babylon and he later took not just Judah but Jerusalem as well. They took many of the young

men like Daniel as slaves. Daniel became famous when he interpreted a dream for King Nebuchadnezzar.

Persia later conquered Babylon and that is where the story of Esther comes from. Esther was the Jewish girl who became the wife of the king of Persia. Queen Esther was an important part of God's plan to save the Jewish people.

After 70 years in captivity God's people were freed to return to Jerusalem. Zerubbabel was one of the first to return and with God's help he oversaw the rebuilding of the temple of God in Jerusalem. A few years later God called another man named Nehemiah to go back to Jerusalem and rebuild the walls of the city for protection and he did.

King Darius took over and decreed that no one could pray to any God but only pray to him. Daniel continued to pray to God just as he always did, even though the king decreed he could no longer pray to his God. King Darius liked Daniel but because he made a law that people would only worship him. The king threw Daniel int the lions' den because he continued to pray to God. God protected Daniel and shut the lions' mouths and they did not eat Daniel or cause him any harm.

Daniel lived to be an old man and the city of Babylon was conquered again by King Belshazzar. King Belshazzar had many parties to celebrate himself and during one party an invisible hand began to write on a wall of fresh plaster in words the king did not understand. The invisible hand writings scared the king and he called for Daniel to come and tell him what the words meant. Daniel came to the drunken party and told Belshazzar the meaning o the handwriting on the wall was his kingdom was about to be conquered by another king. The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! John the Baptist baptized with just water symbolizing a rebirth in a new way of life. After Jesus was raised from the water at His baptism God showed his approval of Jesus and the Holy Spirit descended on Him and the Father said "This is my dearly loved Son, who brings me great joy. Then John the Baptist told everyone Jesus would baptize with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

Jesus went from his baptism to pray and fast and was tempted by Satan. During Jesus' temptation he went without eating for forty days and nights.

After defeating Satan's temptations with the word of God Jesus began selecting his disciples. Andrew was first and when he went to tell his brother Simon Peter he announced, "We have found the Messiah". Andrew and Peter were fishermen and they had two friends who were fishermen which Jesus called as well. These first four apostles were Peter, Andrew, James, and John. Another disciple was a tax collector name Matthew who wrote a gospel. Nicodemus was a ruler of the Jews that came to Jesus by night seeking the way to eternal life. He is important not as an apostle but played part in Jesus' burial and resurrection.

Jesus (12)

Jesus had many people who wanted to follow him. There is a story of a rich young leader who asked to follow Jesus but failed. When Jesus asked him to sell all he had first and give to the poor he could not. Because he loved the things he owned more than Jesus he failed to follow Jesus. Jesus prophesied the Temple would be destroyed and that not one stone would be left on another.

Jesus' first miracle was turning water into wine at a wedding in Cana. Jesus did many miracles and even showed His power for nature by calming a storm on the Sea of Galilee. His most famous sermon is called the Sermon on the Mount where he described people beginning with the words "God Blesses" they were later called the Beatitudes because in the original language they all began with the same letters "beati"

About this time John the Baptist was thrown in prison by King Herod. His stepdaughter persuaded King Herod to kill John the Baptist by beheading him.

Jesus proved over and over he was the Son of God. Once he took Peter, James, and John to a high mountain. While up

there Jesus' appearance was transformed, and he talked with Moses and Elijah. Proving again he was the Son of God.

Jesus taught his disciples many things, there was once while teaching his disciples he asked them who they thought he was. Peter replied in Matthew 16:16 saying "You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God." The three disciples Peter, James, and John were Jesus' closest friends, and this is best shown in that they were the three chosen to go up on the high mountain where he was transformed and spoke to Moses and Elijah.

A disciple is a learner of Jesus. Jesus taught with parables telling familiar stories and later explaining to his disciples the spiritual truths. There is the parable of the wise and foolish man who built a house. The foolish man built on sand which was an example of those who hear His teachings but do not obey them. The wise man built on the rock which showed those who hear His teachings and follow them. Jesus also told the parable of the Good Samaritan who helped the man who was beaten and robbed and then explaining to his disciples this is the example we should follow. The parable of the Prodigal Son, prodigal means wasteful. The son left his father taking his inheritance and spending it all to the point he could not take care of himself, the son repented, and the father took him back in with forgiveness. Jesus was telling us in the Prodigal Son story, God is willing to forgive and restore the sinner who repents. Jesus was asked should we pay taxes, and his answer was "Give Caesar what belongs to Caesar and give God what belongs to God."

Jesus (8)

Jesus not only taught but did many miracles. There was the man born blind and Jesus put mud on his eyes and told him to go and wash it off and the man could see. Jesus was teaching to a group of five thousand men, plus women and children. Jesus took a boy's lunch of five loaves and two fishes and fed everyone. Zacchaeus was a tax collector and became so curious to see Jesus he climbed a tree to see him. The miracle is that Zacchaeus repented and became an honest tax collector, returning to the people he had cheated four times over and he gave half of everything he had to the poor because of Jesus.

In Jesus last days before his crucifixion, he came into Jerusalem riding on the colt of a donkey in a Triumphal Entry fulfilling an Old Testament prophecy. He had a last supper with his disciples and humbly washed each of the

disciple's feet. This was the night before his crucifixion and Jesus went to the garden of Gethsemane to pray. After he prayed, Roman guards came to arrest him. Judas Iscariot one of his apostles betrayed him with a kiss and showing the guards which man was Jesus. Jesus was taken before several rulers before they finally sentenced him to death on the cross. Peter followed as close as he could because he was anxious about the outcome. Three times he was confronted about being one of Jesus' disciples and three times he denied it. On the last denial a rooster crowed. Peter ran away because he remembered Jesus had prophesied that Peter would deny knowing Jesus three times.

When Jesus was brought before Pilate, Pilate could not find any fault with Jesus. In the hopes of saving Jesus, he offered the people a choice between releasing Barabbas a convicted thief and robber and Jesus. The people chose to ask Pilate to release Barabbas instead of Jesus.

Jesus was sentence to death by being crucified and nailed to a cross on a hill called "Golgotha" which means The Place of the Skull. Pilate had a marker placed on Jesus' cross which read "Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews". As Jesus hung on the cross the sun became dark for three hours and there was an earthquake. The Bible tells us the Roman officer who oversaw Jesus' execution said, "This man truly was the Son of God!" and then Jesus died.

After Jesus had died, Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus wrapped his body and buried him in a tomb. There were people who worried Jesus body would be stolen and had Pilate put guards outside his tomb. On the third day angels came and rolled away the stone in front of Jesus' tomb and the guards ran away afraid. Mary Magdalene and a friend came that morning and Mary Magdalene was the first person to see Jesus after He was resurrected. She ran quickly back to town to tell the other disciples. All but Thomas saw Jesus shortly after in a closed room and when the others told Thomas he at first doubted Jesus' was resurrected. Thomas believed when he saw him. More than 500 people saw Jesus after he was raised from the dead. Jesus' Apostles walked and talked with him for about 40 days after his resurrection and then he was taken up into a cloud until they could no longer see him.

Jesus (19)

Jesus Apostles then went to Jerusalem to pray and wait for the Holy Spirit. While waiting they chose to replace Judas as an Apostle and chose Matthias a man who had traveled with them since Jesus was baptized by John the Baptist.

On the day of Pentecost there were 120 people waiting together in an upstairs room for the coming of the Holy Spirit. The Old Testament prophet Joel had foretold the outpouring of the Holy Spirit and it was on the day of Pentecost the gift of God was given to the Church, the Gift of the Holy Spirit.

Peter began to preach a sermon afterward to the people near the building. There were about 3000 people saved because of Peter's sermon on the Day of Pentecost.

One day Peter and a friend were going to church and there was a lame man at the temple gate and God healed him after Peter said to him: Acts 3:6 "I don't have any silver or gold for you. But I'll give you what I have. In the name of Jesus Christ, the Nazarene, get up and walk!"

The church grew and with honesty and love the people gave and shared everything with one another. A husband-and-wife Ananias and Saphira joined the church and lied to the Holy Spirit about what they had to share and were punished for their sin.

Early in the new church the apostles were preaching in the Jewish temple and converting so many to Jesus that the High Priests became jealous and had them arrested, beaten and shamed. This did not stop them but only made them more determined to work for Jesus because they were counted it worthy to suffer disgrace for the name of Jesus.

The Apostle Peter was a great leader in the early church, he raised Tabitha from the dead in answer to prayer. There was the Roman officer Cornelius who sent for Peter to come and preach to him. While Peter was preaching at Cornelius's house the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the message, they were all saved, filled with the Holy Spirit, and baptized in water. Once King Herod arrested Peter and was going to kill him for preaching. Other Christians began to pray, and an angel opened the prison for Peter and freed him.

Eventually the persecution of the new church went beyond beatings, and many were killed or martyred for being a Christian. History tells all but one of the Apostles were martyred for preaching the Good News and that was John who wrote a gospel, three epistles and the book of Revelation. The first person to be martyred for being a Christian was Stephen and early convert of the new church.

Saul of Tarsus was there when Stephen was killed, and he worked hard to arrest many Christians. While Saul was on the road to Damascus to arrest Christians, Jesus appeared to him in a light from heaven, and Saul accepted Him as Lord. God changed Saul's name to Paul when he was converted. Paul became a leader in the new Church and went on to write 13 books of the Bible, more than any other person. Paul went on three missionary journeys; the first Barnabas went with him. When they were preaching in Antioch people first called Jesus' followers Christians. In Lystra many people thought Paul was a God because of miracles God performed through him. The people of Lystra stoned him and left him for dead, but God healed him. On Paul's 2nd missionary journey his chief helpers were Silas and Timothy. Paul and Silas were put in prison and God freed them with an earthquake, afterward Paul told the Philippian jailer how to be saved, Acts 16:31 says, "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved, along with everyone in your household". It was while on this journey God showed Paul a vision of a man from Macedonia calling for help. Luke accompanied Paul on some his journeys. Luke was very smart and was a doctor by occupation, Luke also wrote the book of Acts and one of the Gospels. Paul was

a tentmaker and in Corinth he became friends with fellow tentmakers Aquilla and Priscilla who assisted him in preaching.

Theological Terms

Not all disciples are apostles, but all apostles are disciples. A disciple is defined as a follower of Jesus and an apostle is a special messenger sent by God. There were 12 apostles but many disciples of Jesus. When Jesus left earth, he commanded his 12 apostles to make disciples of all nations.

The teachings from the Bible are called doctrine and it is the guide we use to make disciples. The doctrine of faith is our shield and faith is belief and complete trust in God.

Sin entered the world through the disobedience of Adam and Eve and ever since we have been under sins curse. John 3:4 tells us sin is breaking God's law and is contrary to the law of God. James 4:17 tells us, knowing to do good and not doing it is sin. In combining the two sin is defined as refusing to do God's will as revealed by His Word and His Spirit. Death is the separation of the body and the soul, and death is the penalty of sin.

God has a plan of salvation and gives it to us with grace. Grace means that God offers us His love and forgiveness as a gift and not because we earned it or deserve it. We are saved from sin by the gracious gift of God in sending his son Jesus to die for our sins. We call the price Jesus paid for our salvation redemption.

God (8)

In order to be saved we must accept God's gracious gift of redemption, with faith and with repentance. Repentance means having a change of mind, heart, and direction. With our acceptance of God's gift, and repentance of our heart. God accepts us as though we had not sinned which is justification. After God's acceptance comes sanctification which is being separated from sin and set apart to serve God. God works through all this with us by the power of the Holy Spirit.

After we are saved, prayer, praise and worship to God become a big part of our life. Prayer is talking to God and 1 Thessalonians 5:17 tells us to "Never stop praying." Praise and worship are very close to the same thing and the wording very similar, so it is important to learn it like a quotation question. Worship is exalting and adoring God for who he is. Praise is expressing our love for God for all He is and all He has done. Worship is from the heart and Praise is action. The wise men when they found Jesus bowed and gave gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh in worship to Gods son.

One thing you can count on is that God is immutable, which means he does not change, He is always the same. That can be reassuring to know God is with us to the end and all we learn from Bible doctrine is immutable, God and the doctrine of the Bible does not change it.
